- Career Exploration & Engagement: Organize the Career Pathways Fair and Speakers Bureau to enhance employer engagement. Provide workshops on resume writing, interviewing skills, business etiquette, and employer expectations.
- **Employer Recruitment**: Recruit employers for career speakers and job fairs, fostering relationships with local businesses to create internship opportunities.
- Collaboration with Schools: Engage with school administration and guidance personnel to promote
 MassHire North Central Student Career Support services. Collaborate with school partners to identify
 and address specific career preparation needs. Collect and submit participant data, including quarterly
 success stories.
