The Massachusetts Broadband Institute at the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (“MBI”) has launched a program for Massachusetts residents.

It provides subsidized internet access and/or an internet accessible device to eligible unemployed participants, and may assist in connecting job seekers with the tools, services and internet connections necessary to “get back to work”.
